They have suggested that they include private hospital, Hospital Director and Hospital Superintendent into the advocacy program. They have also suggested that promotion of optimal prescribing and dispensing of AMR need to be implemented. They have also suggested reforming the Task Force to Monitor Antimicrobial Consumption System in Bangladesh.

In the meeting representatives from DLS informed that they have provided 05 days training on AMR/AMU to 1200 officers. They are working on import data, production data and field use data. The Farm Assessment and monitoring program is going on. They have also informed that form their surveillance they have observed use of sulfonamide has been increased.

In the meeting ICDDR, B presented the point prevalence study protocol which they have developed to perform point prevalence study in Bangladesh. The Task force has approved their point prevalence study protocol.

Prof. Md. Sayedur Rahman said that to conduct AMC/AMU surveillance in Bangladesh, we need to develop protocol/SOP. Then it will be very systematic. BSMMU will provide support to DGDA to conduct AMC/AMU surveillance in Bangladesh and to develop AMC/AMU surveillance protocol/SOP.
